





## **Glenageary Road Upper Travel Active Scheme**

Dear Residents,

Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, in conjunction with the National Transport Authority, has planned Active Travel Improvement Scheme on Glenageary Road Upper between the Sallynoggin and Killiney Towers Roundabouts.

Lane Closures will be in place from Wednesday, 7<sup>th</sup> August 2024 to Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2024, with a one-way system being maintained 24Hrs from Sallynoggin roundabout to Killiney Towers roundabout in various phases in order to carry out the final layer of resurfacing on Glenageary Road Upper.

On **Friday 9th and Monday 12<sup>th</sup> August** a lane closure will be in place from **Sallynoggin roundabout to Adelaide junction (Eastbound lane)** for road milling and resurfacing works.

During this time, there will be restricted access for residents between Carmona School and Adelaide junction in order to carry out these works. We will need to remove the temporary tar at the front of each driveway and resurface the road in front of houses entrances restricting access and egress for a period of time each day.

- We ask Residents between Carmona School and Altadore junction to have left their property before 08:00am on Friday Morning 9<sup>th</sup> August as resurfacing works will be commencing. Access and egress will be restricted from 08:00am until 18:00pm.
- We ask Residents between Altadore and Adelaide Junction to have left their property before 08:00am on Monday Morning 12<sup>th</sup> August as resurfacing works will be commencing. Access and egress will be restricted from 08:00am until 18:00pm
- The entrance to Cluain Mhuire Junction and Altadore junction will require milling and resurfacing works at the junction with a Stop & Go traffic management operation being carried out on Friday 9th and Monday 12<sup>th</sup> August. There may be delays during the day when resurfacing through these junction in order to complete the road resurfacing which is unavoidable.
- Residents of Cluain Mhuire and Altadore Junction will not be permitted to turn right from Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> to Monday 12<sup>th</sup> August towards Sallynoggin Roundabout during this time and must follow the diversion signs as previously carried out.


We ask for the residents to work with the contractor during this time. We also ask that some residents find alternative parking for the day where possible in order for the works to be complete as soon as possible and allow full access back to residents each evening.

It will not be possible to maintain access/egress throughout the day of resurfacing for these properties but as always, we will work with the residents that require access with certain circumstances when possible.

Advance notice of diversion routes will be clearly sign posted on all approaches and notification will be given for the various lane closures for each phase for the duration of the works.
